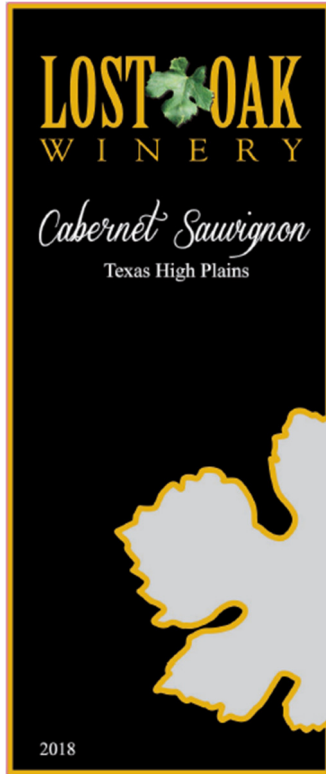


Cabernet Sauvignon 2018

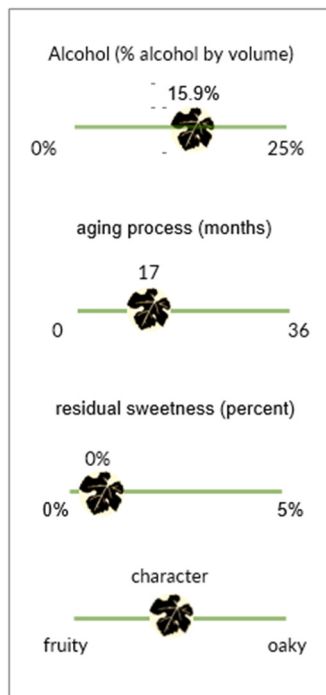


WINEMAKER NOTES

Cabernet Sauvignon (kab-er-nay sah-vin-youn) is one of the world's most popular grapes. It is grown in almost every grape growing region and is often seen as a single varietal but is also used in many blends, including those from Bordeaux. Its versatility allows it to express many different flavor profiles depending on where it was grown. Texas Cabernet Sauvignon tends to be more fruit forward, expressing less minerality and tannin than those from other growing regions.

TASTING NOTES

The hue of this exciting Cabernet Sauvignon is a deep ruby, almost black. The aroma is a bright contrast, expressing cherries and currants. The strong berry character carries over to the palate with gusto. It finishes with a lingering mouth feel, hint of coffee and dark chocolate, and structured tannins.

26% Cabernet Sauvignon from Bingham Family Vineyards Meadow, TX
6% Petit Verdot from Sprayberry Vineyards, Midland, TX

French and American oak

Pair this wine with classic lasagnas, grilled rib-eye steak, margarita pizza with fresh basil, or dark chocolate with raspberries.
