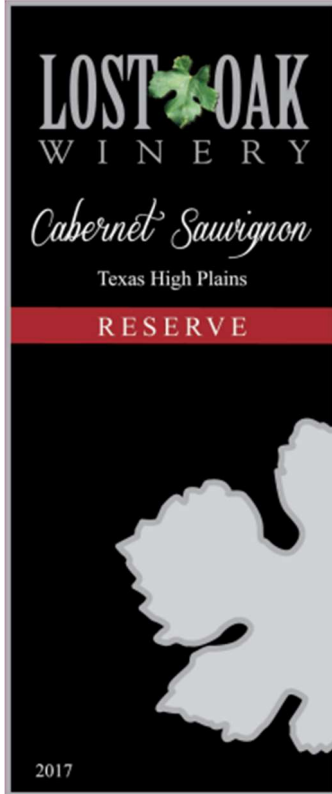


# Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve 2017



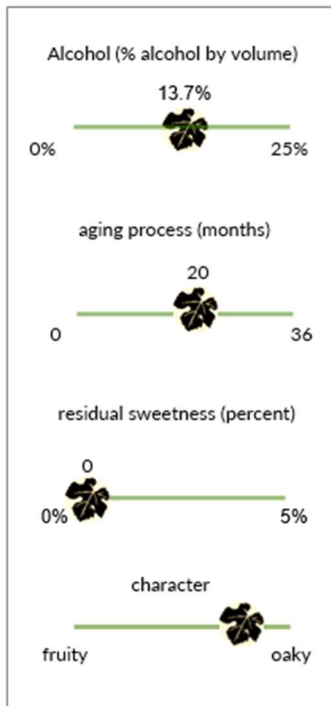
## WINEMAKER NOTES

Cabernet Sauvignon (kab-er-nay saw-vin-yawn) originates in the Bordeaux region of France. DNA testing has revealed it to be a crossing of Cabernet Franc and Sauvignon Blanc. It is thought to be the most popular wine making grape in the world as it tends to grow well in most growing regions.

Every so often a wine of exceptional quality is chosen to be released as a limited case, reserve bottling. This Reserve wine was picked by winemakers, Jim Evens and Ty Berringer to be an ideal representation of Texas Cabernet Sauvignon.

## TASTING NOTES

With its distinctive brick red color, this Cabernet Sauvignon is decadent and rich. Aromas of dark currents with hints of coffee and chocolate are complemented by subtle flavors of vanilla and cinnamon. Full body with mouth coating dark berry flavors that finish with lingering waves of structured tannins and cherries.
