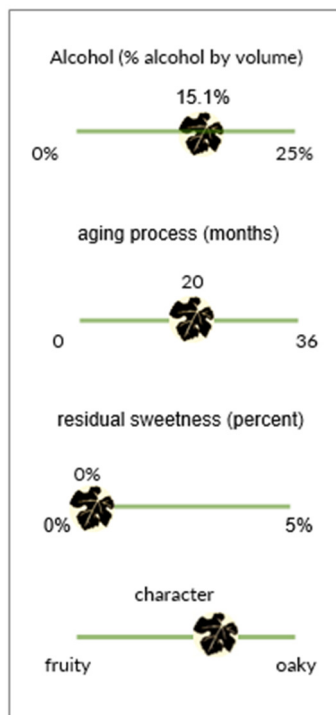
WINEMAKER NOTES

What's in a name? The word Meritage is a combination of the words merit and heritage and is pronounced like heritage. It is a registered trademark of The Meritage Alliance. Their goal is to foster exceptional wines blended in the Bordeaux tradition. Meritage wines are handcrafted, red or white wines blended from the "noble" Bordeaux grape varieties.

TASTING NOTES

With a beautiful endless garnet hue, this Meritage has soft aromas of boysenberry and vanilla. When it comes to flavor, Bing cherries are the star of the show. Hints of blackberry and huckleberry, along with soft baking spice, accompany cherry on the finish. Rounded tannins linger on the palate to finish this exceptional Meritage off.
