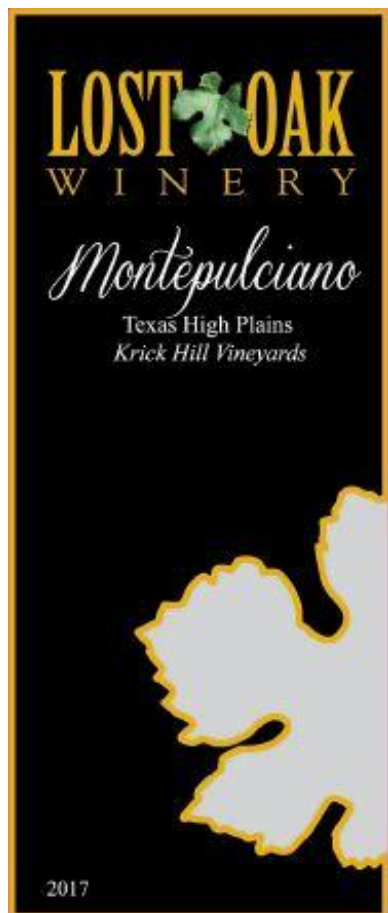


# Montepulciano 2017
