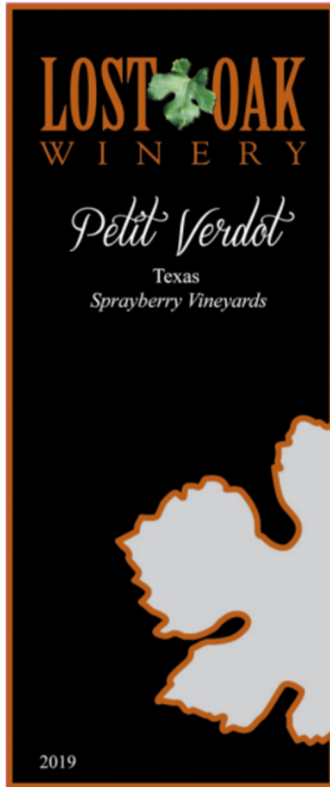


# Petit Verdot 2019



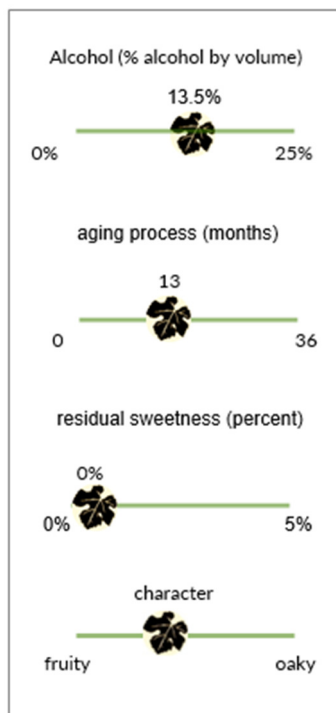
## WINEMAKER NOTES

Petit Verdot (peh-tee vur-doe) originates in southwestern France. It is mostly used as a blending grape in Bordeaux style reds. It is known for its intense color.

## TASTING NOTES

With an intense color so dark it is almost black, this Petit Verdot starts off big and bold. Rich aromas of blackberry, black cherry, and plum with just a hint of earthiness and leather overwhelms the senses. Flavors of dark berries carry over to the palate and are accompanied by a spicy finish of bay leaves and cardamon. Soft tannins leave you with a lingering finish of passion fruit and boysenberry.
