THE STORY

The Caddo word for sun is Saku and according to the creation story, the first Caddo climbed up from darkness beneath the earth to the New World of Light or Sun. The man brought fire, a pipe, and a drum. His wife brought pumpkin and corn seed. Stories such as this have been told and retold to Caddo children, from one generation to the next. Lost Oak winery honors the Caddo and the wonderful traditions of their culture.
