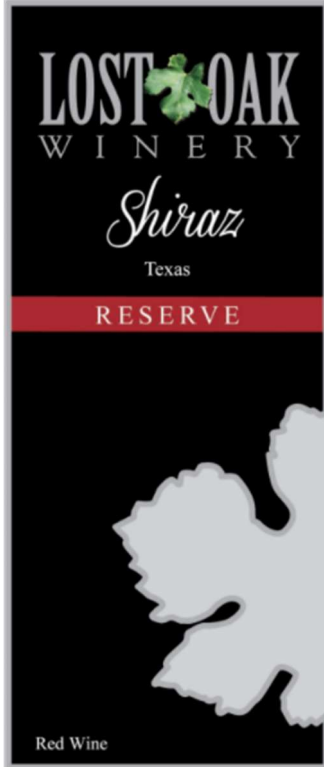


# Shiraz Reserve Non-vintage

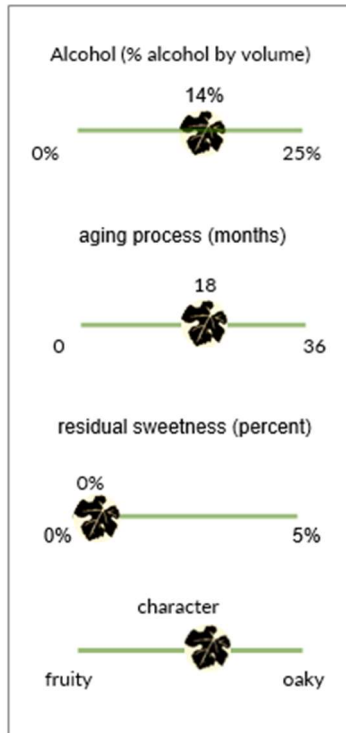


## WINEMAKER NOTES

Sometimes the best way to taste the true expression of a vineyard is to blend multiple vintages together. This Shiraz Reserve is just that, the expression of three different harvests from Lost Oak's vineyard. Shiraz from 2016, 2017, and 2018 blend together to make an exceptional tasting experience. Oak-aged to perfection, and well worth the wait this Shiraz Reserve is the product of patience and love for the land it was grown on. It may be 3 different vintages, but 35 years of growing experience has gone into bringing this wine to your table.

## TASTING NOTES

This wonderful Texas Shiraz has a rich ruby hue and supple legs that cling to the glass. The bouquet is a vibrant mix of ripe red berries and jam. Flavors of rich cherries, and black plum fade into decadent vanilla and soft oak notes. This Shiraz finishes strong with flavors of mocha and caramel tempered with balanced tannins and a lingering mouth feel.
