## TASTING NOTES

Tempranillo has found a home in the High Plains of Texas where the warm days and cool nights are much like that of Spain. Aromas of ripe red fruit, mainly black cherry, blend perfectly with the leather and oak of this Tempranillo. Our hope is that you will appreciate this fine wine from Bingham Family Vineyard High Plains grapes as much as we do.

## PRODUCTION NOTES

High Plains Grapes from Bingham Family Vineyards were crushed and fermented "Small Lot" style in macrobins for 10 days. The wine was then pressed and aged in American oak for 10 months.
